Call for Artists: Open to painting, mixed media, digital, illustration photography, sculpture, and poetry by emerging and under-recognized artists from 16 years old to 32 years old. Select artwork created for the special theme “*Down the Rabbit Hole*” (see description on back side) will be juried and exhibited in a separate gallery space. Reception will be Friday night May 12th and Saturday afternoon May 13th at Brooks College – Sunnyvale.

Eligibility:

- Open to all emerging California artists and poets from 16 years old to 32 years old.
- Work can be wall-hung, free-standing or pedestal mounted.
- Work must be hand delivered to Brooks College – Sunnyvale
- Wall-hung work may not exceed 105” height x 72” width x 12” depth (including frame), and not weigh over 50 lbs.
- Free standing work may not exceed 114” in height.
- All work must be original.
- Maximum of 2 entries per artist in open theme exhibit and 1 entry per artist in “*Down the Rabbit Hole*” juried exhibit.

Selection: Work will be selected after hand delivery to Brooks College; Heart of Chaos themed work will be juried before May 12th and winners announced on Friday night at the opening.

To Enter: Deliver framed (ready to hang) photography and artwork (canvases don’t need to be framed) and/or poetry (framed and illustrated poetry optional) to Brooks College of Sunnyvale on May 1- May 9th between 9 am and 7 pm on weekdays and 9 am -1pm on Saturday (Not Sunday) All work must have entry labels fastened securely on the back and one entry form for each artist must be completed. You may sell your work and all transactions are between the artist and the seller. We will provide artists with contracts to protect their rights in the event that they choose to sell original pieces.

Non-refundable Entry Fees: \$5.00 per artist/poet. Make checks out to Catalyst for Youth. Cash also accepted when work is delivered. Please ask for a cash receipt.

Awards: Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Best of Show and merit award certificates

Receptions: Two receptions will be held at Brooks College – Sunnyvale on Friday night May 10th from 5 pm–9:30 pm and Saturday May 11th from 12 Noon–4 pm. Celebrate the art and the artists and enjoy live painting demos, spoken word, music & food.

Down the Rabbit Hole Juried Competition

Artwork created and poetry written for the “*Down the Rabbit Hole*” juried competition must reflect this catch phrase that comes from the topsy-turvy world that Alice in Wonderland discovered. It is also a line from the popular movie *What the Bleep Do We Know Anyway*, a look at what quantum mechanics has revealed about the nature of reality—a shifting view of the world with parallel universes and mind boggling paradoxes.

In short, our physical reality turns out to be a bizarre and magical underworld. For example, what you observe depends upon what you choose to observe. That means you see only what you believe. And since the physical stuff of our world responds to our consciousness, the power of our personal focus and intention is the new frontier. Use your imagination and intuition to interpret the theme for this special exhibit. A limited number of work will be selected by the HOC directors to be judged by outside jurors. Cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places.
